Handles with a leather grip unite the best of traditional and modern. Warm and natural to look at, they are firm and pleasant to touch and grip. They help create an ambience of solid luxury.

Info tip Leather handles and knobs

Processing:

- Leather is a wholly natural product obtained from animal hides made soft and supple by various processes.
- To give the handle its rigid form and to set coloured highlights, a handle on the base of zinc, wood or plastic is used as substrate. This part of the handle is also tapped for subsequent fixing to the furniture.
- The leather is cut and sewn to the shape of the handle and then glued or pinned onto the substrate.

Finish:

- The napa leather used keeps the natural grain of the hide.
- For a more uniform appearance and greater resistance to fading, a pigment coating can be applied to the leather.
- In use, the leather will age to produce an interesting patina and create a feel of enduring value.

Applications:

- Leather handles are used mainly on luxury furniture for living areas or in exclusive consulting rooms and offices.
